Aim of the Course:

The aim of the course is to train pilots to the level of theoretical knowledge proficiency necessary for issue of an Airline Transport Pilots Licence ATPL (A).

The Course Comprises:

Three distinct ground school modules, covering the 14 subjects required for the JAA ATPL (A) Theory, trained over forty weeks, excluding brush up courses and examination time comprising: Study hours 690.

Module 1 – 13 weeks correspondence course plus 1 week consolidation training required for the sitting of the first 5 JAA ground examinations. Subjects HPL, M & B, Met, Performance and Principles of Flight.

Module 2 – 13 weeks correspondence course plus 1 week consolidation training required for the sitting of 4 JAA ground examinations. Subjects Flight Planning, Gen Nav, Air Law, Rnav.

Module 3 – 14 weeks correspondence course plus 1 week consolidation training for the sitting of the final exams. Subjects Airframe and Systems, Electrics, Instruments. Operational Procedures, Powerplant, IFR and VFR Comms.

The 14 JAA subjects are Air Law, Aircraft General Knowledge (Airframe / Systems / Powerplant), Instruments / Electronics, Mass & Balance, Performance, Flight Planning, Human Performance & Limitations, Meteorology, General Navigation, Radio Navigation, Operational Procedures, Principles of Flight, VFR Communications, and IFR Communications.

The course price includes all tuition fees and course materials, but EXCLUDES the supply of mandatory course equipment including a CRP-5 Flight Computer, Jeppesen Student Route Manual, and Square Protractor.

The UK CAA require all distance learning students to complete not less than 10% full time ground school tuition so in order to achieve this we hold a scheduled classroom study week at the end of each module and before students sit exams.

Entrance Requirements:

An applicant for the ATPL Full Time course must be the holder of a PPL (A) or CPL (A) issued in accordance with ICAO Annex 1. The course applicant should have sufficient knowledge of Mathematics and Physics to facilitate an understanding of the Theoretical Knowledge instruction content of the course. An applicant shall also demonstrate the ability to use the English language in flight, on the ground, and to understand all information relevant to the planning and accomplishment of a flight.
