Aim of the Course:

The aim of the course is to train pilots to the level of theoretical knowledge proficiency necessary for issue of an Airline Transport Pilots Licence ATPL (A).

The Course Comprises:

Three distinct ground school modules, trained over twenty seven weeks of full time tuition (including time for examination revision and sittings) covering the 14 subjects required for the JAA ATPL (A) Theory. Study hours 690.

Module 1 – 7 weeks full time training plus 1 week for the first ground examination sitting for the initial 5 subjects.

Module 2 – 7 weeks full time training plus 1 week for the second ground examination sitting for the next 4 subjects.

Module 3 – 7 weeks full time training plus 1 week for the final ground examination sitting for the final 5 subjects.

The 14 JAA subjects are Air Law, Aircraft General Knowledge (Airframe / Systems / Powerplant), Instruments / Electronics, Mass & Balance, Performance, Flight Planning, Human Performance & Limitations, Meteorology, General Navigation, Radio Navigation, Operational Procedures, Principles of Flight, VFR Communications, and IFR Communications.

The course price includes all tuition fees, initial supply of training manuals including the Student Pilot Route Manual, but excludes mandatory course equipment including a CRP-5 Flight Computer, Compass dividers and Scientific Calculator, Flight Ruler, Square Protractor and Plotter.

Entrance Requirements:

An applicant for the ATPL Full Time course must be the holder of a PPL (A) or CPL (A) issued in accordance with ICAO Annex 1. The course applicant should have sufficient knowledge of Mathematics and Physics to facilitate an understanding of the Theoretical Knowledge instruction content of the course. An applicant shall also demonstrate the ability to use the English language in flight, on the ground, and to understand all information relevant to the planning and accomplishment of a flight.
