Aim of the Course:

The aim of the CPL/MEP (A) IR Holder modular course is to train PPL (A) holders to the level of proficiency necessary for the issue of a CPL/MEP (A).

The Course Comprises:

10 hours instruction in a DA40 Diamond

5 hours simulator instruction

8 hours instruction in a DA42 Diamond Twin Star Visual and Instrument flying instruction, MEP theoretical knowledge and twin aircraft training.

Entrance Requirements:

Before commencing a CPL/MEP (A) IR Holder modular course an applicant shall be the holder of a PPL (A) and Instrument Rating (A) having completed not less than 150 hours flight time as a pilot, of which 70 hours must be pilot in command (PIC).

The applicant must hold a JAA Class One Medical.

Licence Issue Requirements:

Before issue of a CPL (A) an applicant shall have achieved 200 hours as pilot of aeroplanes, 100 hours of which must be as Pilot in Command (PIC). The PIC time must include at least 20 hours cross-country flight including a 300nm flight with two full landings at intermediate and different aerodromes. In addition an applicant will require 10 hours instrument instruction time, Night Qualification (5 hours) and have successfully completed the theoretical knowledge requirements for issue of a CPL (A).

Course Duration:

Approximately 5 weeks, depending on time of year and weather conditions.
