Aim of the Course:

The aim of the course is to train pilots to the level of practical flying and theoretical knowledge proficiency necessary for issue of a Night Qualification.

The Course Comprises:

The course comprises a minimum of 5 hours flight training including 3 hours of dual instruction, of which 1 hour will be a night cross country navigation, and 5 solo circuits which will include 5 take-offs and 5 full-stop landings.

All ground training and pre/post flight briefings are included in the course.

Entrance Requirements:

Before commencing the Night Qualification modular course an applicant shall be the holder of a PPL (A) unless the module forms part of the PPL training course.

2 nights (minimum)
